

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEDICAL CHECK UP

Kindly find the following general instructions for your reference and further action:

- Get enough sleep, at least 6 hours prior to the check-up. Lack of sleep may cause abnormal results such as blood pressure, heart beat& body temperature. The physician may not be able to assess if any change is a real abnormality;
- Do not eat or drink at least 8 to 10 hours prior to the check-up. Water, however may be freely taken to avoid dehydration effects on blood sugar & cholesterol test in the program;
- Hypertension medicine can be taken prior to your visit;
- Urine samples will be collected on the day of examination;
 # For female applicant only: please postpone your medical examination during your menstruation
- Please wear clothing allowing access to upper arm;
- Should you have any chronic illnesses or other health issues, please bring along any test results or medical report with you to assist in diagnosis;
- ❖ If pregnant, please inform the Customer Service upon registration to cancel the x-ray.

If you are scheduled to perform a Stress Test:

- Please bring your sport shoes;
- Should you need to consume any food before a stress test, please have a light snack and avoid any fatty foods, caffeine and alcohol;
- If you are under-going treatment or taking medication for any medical or physical condition, please notify the nurse in advance;
- If you are suffering any chest pain or breathing difficulty, please notify the nurse in advance.

If you are scheduled to perform a Mammogram:

- Please do not apply any powder, perfume or deodorant on your chest area;
- Please wear loose fitting clothing that is easy to remove i.e. baggy t-shirt or tops with front buttons instead of zippers behind.



If you are scheduled for a Pap Smear Test:

- Two days prior to the test date please avoid douching or using vaginal medication or any form of spermicide, tampons and any vaginal creams unless instructed by a doctor;
- Please also avoid having any sexual intercourse / copulation;
- ❖ All the above-mentioned could wash away or conceal abnormal cells which would hinder / obstruct an accurate testing.

If you are have Colonoscopy included into your package:

- Please inform us when you would like to have the test so as we may arrange an appointment for you;
- Kindly be informed that you will require two days of preparation prior to undertaking the test;
- ❖ You will also require two bottles of Fleet Phospho to clean your bowls a day before the test;
- ❖ You may obtain the Fleet from us directly please advise us when so as we may arrange for it from the Specialist Clinic;
- ❖ If you were to purchase the Fleet directly from the Specialist Clinic it would be chargeable
